

Project Service To Others 2018

*RTO/ERO proudly operates a grant program for its 48 Districts, providing \$100,000 to sponsor local community projects and raise the profile of RTO/ERO. Through **Project Service to Others (STO)**, Districts may apply for individual projects that support local, national and international programs that often involve children and/or disadvantaged groups, to a maximum of a onetime only grant of \$4,000 per project. Each year, one project must be selected and approved by the District 3 Algoma executive, before proceeding to the Provincial Committee.*

RTO/ERO Local District 3 Algoma has successfully submitted projects in the past, including Battle of the Books, Camp McDougal, St John's After School programme, Vision Screening, Rockhaven School, Tumaini Afrika and this year Elliot Lake's Roundabout Exceptional Puppeteers.

Include in your summary:

- *the nature and scope of your proposed project, including how it supports community, volunteerism, children, and/or disadvantaged groups on local, national and/or international levels. Please be specific and focus on one area of a larger project and explain how your project would be impacted by the receipt of this donation. If you have cost projections and timelines, they would be helpful too.*
- *the RTO/ERO members involved in the project and the nature of their involvement.*
- *what partnerships are anticipated?*
- *a willingness to work with the local executive to fine-tune the final application to RTO/ERO, should your project be selected by the local executive.*
